## About Our Camp...

Madison College Baseball is offering an outstanding baseball camp opportunity for players ages 7-18. This four-session camp will provide an excellent environment for individuals to learn new baseball skills and techniques while preparing for upcoming baseball tryouts and the 2010 season. This camp will enroll quickly, so submit your application today.

### INSTRUCTION

Individual instruction on the fundamentals of throwing, hitting, bunting, fielding, and base running as well as baseball strategy will be covered. Emphasis will be placed on hitting skills, drills, and techniques while incorporating live batting practice. A 3:1 player to instructor ratio enables detailed individualized instruction to take place. Campers will receive instruction and work at individual positions throughout the camp.

### GOAL OF THE CAMP

Our goal is to combine the knowledge and enthusiasm of the Spring Training Baseball Camp staff with the enthusiasm and abilities of the campers to learn and improve on baseball skills and techniques. The camp will prepare players for their upcoming try-outs and 2010 baseball seasons.

### EQUIPMENT NEEDED

All campers are responsible for their own baseball gloves, hats, and any protective equipment. Bats, balls, and helmets will be provided by the camp. Individuals with their own bats and equipment are highly encouraged to bring them. The use of batting gloves is also recommended due to the large quantity of swings taken. Please clearly mark all equipment. Tennis shoes must be worn in the facility. No hard soled shoes or spikes are allowed. Each camper will be given a T-shirt for participating in the camp.
